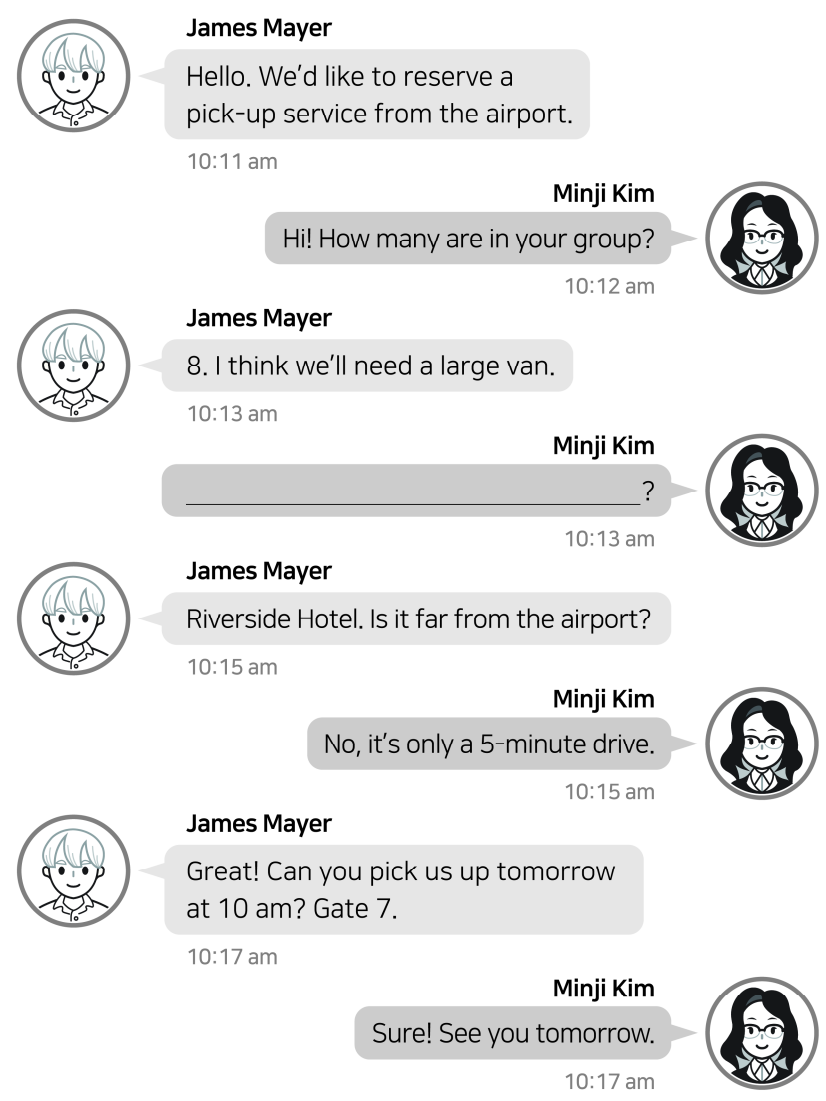

Household Hazardous Waste

Leftover household products that can catch fire or explode under certain circumstances are considered household hazardous waste (HHW). Although it depends on your local solid waste agency or recycling facility, some examples include pesticides, paints, light bulbs, batteries, and nail polish. These products require special care when you dispose of them. HHW may be dangerous to people and bad for the environment if they are poured down the drain, dumped on the ground, or thrown out with regular trash.

What you can do:

- Try to reduce your purchases of these products, and look for alternative, non-hazardous products.
- When you need to dispose of these products, look for special collection events in your community or permanent collection centers.
- If you have to dispose of HHW, first check with your local waste management agency to learn what rules apply in your community.

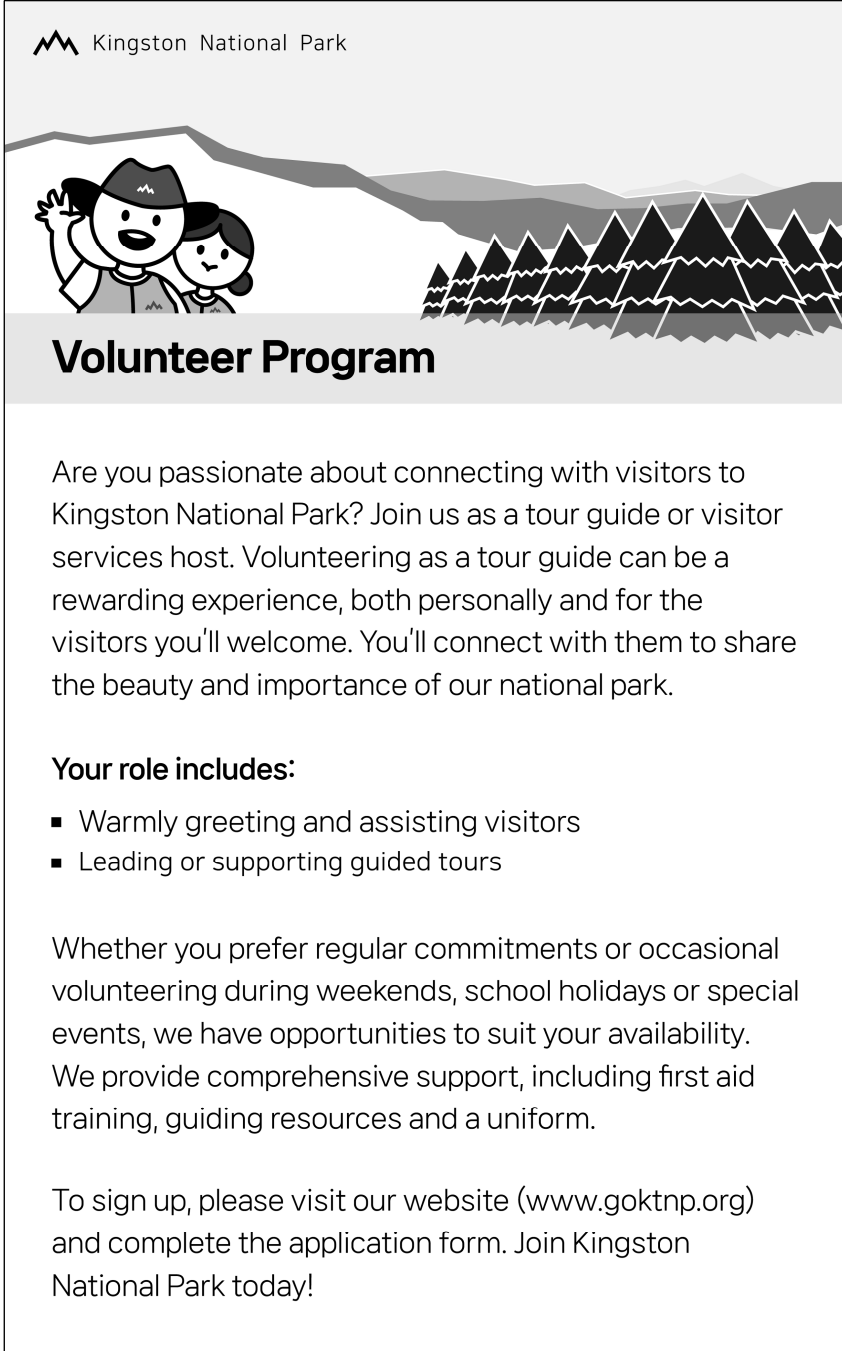

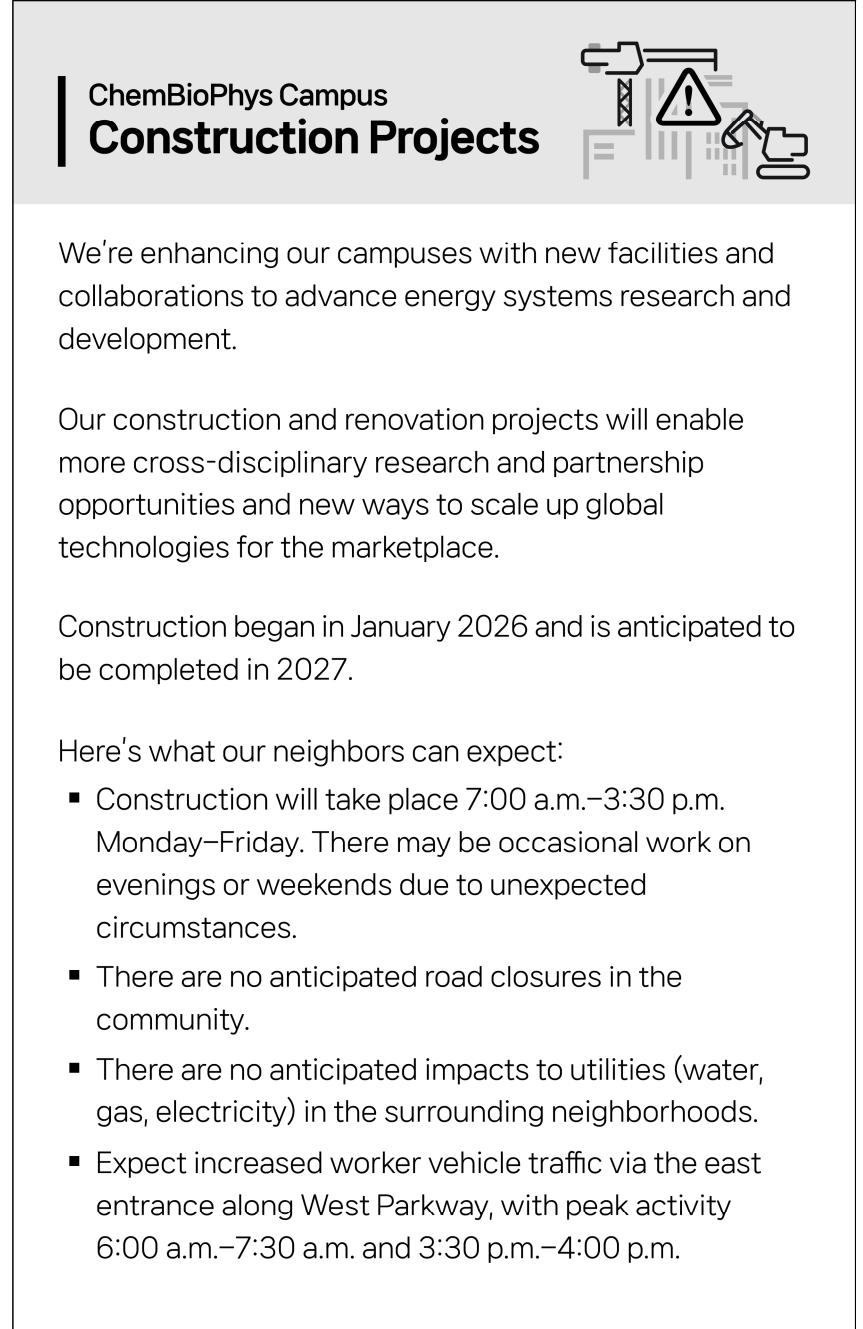

We're enhancing our campuses with new facilities and collaborations to advance energy systems research and development.

Our construction and renovation projects will enable more cross-disciplinary research and partnership opportunities and new ways to scale up global technologies for the marketplace.

Construction began in January 2026 and is anticipated to be completed in 2027.

Here's what our neighbors can expect:

- Construction will take place 7:00 a.m.–3:30 p.m. Monday–Friday. There may be occasional work on evenings or weekends due to unexpected circumstances.
- There are no anticipated road closures in the community.
- There are no anticipated impacts to utilities (water, gas, electricity) in the surrounding neighborhoods.
- Expect increased worker vehicle traffic via the east entrance along West Parkway, with peak activity 6:00 a.m.–7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.–4:00 p.m.

Personality typing is a system of categorizing people ① depending on how they think and act in certain situations—but there are clear differences between different personality type systems and what they can tell you about yourself. The Myers and Briggs personality system and the Enneagram of Personality are two leading personality typing systems ② that are used around the world. Both systems help people ③ gains a better insight into their career possibilities, the dynamics of their relationships, the working patterns of their employees and even their own thought patterns. Some personality typologists prefer ④ to use one system over the other but the two systems are often used together. Each has their own strengths and weaknesses.

Moltbook was developed in the wake of Moltbot, a free and open-source AI bot that can act as an automated agent for users—doing the mundane tasks assigned to it such as reading, summarising and responding to emails, organising a calendar or ④ book a table at a restaurant.

Giraffes may all look identical to us. But none has exactly the same markings—and certain patterns, especially large, round patches, can boost their chances of survival before they turn 4 months old. Biologists can’t decide why giraffes evolved patches. David Lee at the Nature Institute in South Carolina and his colleagues examined 258 wild baby Masai giraffes in Tanzania for clues to the impact of patches on the animals. They found that calves with fewer, larger spots had a 17 percent higher chance of survival than those with more, smaller spots. They also found that those with more round spots had a 27 percent higher survival rate than those with elliptical* spots.

And it turns out that the colors that our language routinely obliges us to treat as distinct can refine our purely visual sensitivity to certain color differences in reality, so that our brains are trained to exaggerate the distance between shades of color if these have different names in our language. As strange as it may sound, our experience of a Chagall painting actually depends to some extent on whether our language has a word for blue.
